Disney Update – Main Group's trip price is \$965. Science Olympiad students' price is \$945. Boosters will pay for Watson buses to and from airport. This is about \$1,000 and drops the price for each student \$20.

The payment schedule is November 22nd - \$250, January 24th - \$350 and March 14th - \$315. (The final payment may be reduced if Boosters account has a surplus.)

Group 1 flies directly from Pittsburgh to Orlando (leaving 2:45pm and arriving 5 pm).

Group 2 leaves at 2:50 pm, with a layover from 3:50 to 4:25pm, arriving in Orlando at 6:40 pm.

They will eat as a group at Planet Hollywood.

A 3-day basic park ticket is \$168 for any other family members.

If any student stays longer, they still pay roundtrip airfare and must arrange the additional days with school.

Before the winter concert, we will need a flight manifest which includes all travelers' full names (as on driver's license), date of birth, gender, and age.

There will be either 5 or 6 students in each suite.

Awards – Pam Gealy reported the 2nd year members' orders are in for blankets or jackets. Hoodies will be ordered next week for 3rd year students. Our 8th graders get T-shirts.

Beef Raffle – The winner was Crystal Hart. The total number of tickets sold was 791, with 763 being sold by students.

Gift Card Wreath Raffle – Tickets or money are due December 4th, and the winner will be drawn December 11th. There are 850 tickets out.

Pittsburgh Penguins Tickets Raffle – Brad Berlin donated 2 tickets for the February 3rd game for us to raffle off. Second prize will be Penguins items.

The 50/50 raised \$130 for the Disney trip fund.
