2. <u>DATES:</u>

a. Band camp will run from <u>Monday, July 26 thru Friday, July 30.</u> Band Camp will be held with all members attending each daily practice at Wilmington Area High School

3. <u>COST:</u>

- a. <u>Student Camp Cost: \$75.000 in the band camp packets student due by July 22</u>
- b. Student band account balances may be used towards the cost of camp registration
- c. Please make checks payable to WILMINGTON AREA BAND BOOSTERS, INC. (WABB) and give to Mr. Nickel OR mail to:

4. <u>LOCATION:</u>

a. As per the school administration's request, band camp will be once again held at Wilmington Area High this year. This decision is a result of current guidelines and recommendations related to covid-19. As many students are still receiving vaccinations, overnight trips/camps are still not permitted by the administration at this time. Students will report to the check-in station at the high school band room entrance each day.

5. <u>FORMS:</u>

- a. <u>Required student forms and packets have been given to the students and emailed home. If a new packet</u> or PDF set of forms is needed please contact me at nickel@wasd.school.
 - i. Electronic Copies will also be available to print:

 - 3. On www.Greyhoundband.org
 - 4. Medical forms, a copy of the student's insurance card, and all other required paperwork must be submitted to Mr. Nickel no later than July 22.

6. <u>TIMES</u>:

- a. Camp will run each day from 8:00am 10:00pm and students will report to the high school main entrance for check-in and the daily pre-screening process as outlined in the Return to Instruction Action Plan that was school board approved in June 2020. Students will not be permitted to leave the campus at any time during the week of camp until they are formally dismissed or given approval by the director to leave.
- b. All students should arrive slightly BEFORE 8:00am to avoid being marked late.
- c. Repeated tardy arrive or unexcused absences may result in demerits, disciplinary actions, or benching from performances.
- d. "If you're on time, you are late....If you are early, you're on time!"
- e. School doors will open by 7:30am each morning for check-in.

7. <u>ATTENDANCE</u>:

a. All students are required to attend and participate in band camp and timely attendance to camp each day is mandatory. Please refer to section II.III regarding the attendance policy and examples in the band camp packet. Mr. Nickel or a member of the band staff should be notified as soon as possible regarding the reason for an absence. If a student fails to attend for any unexcused reason or is tardy to rehearsal, they may incur demerits, disciplinary actions, or possible suspension or expulsion from the organization. Students will not be excused during the week of camp for non-emergency related matters.

b. <u>Please avoid scheduling any appointments this during this week since it is critical that they students</u> <u>are in attendance each day for the full day of rehearsals.</u>

8. <u>FOOD:</u>

- a. <u>Students will need to bring a packed lunch each day. Lunches will be stored in the airconditioned</u> <u>cafeteria.</u>
- b. Dinner will be provided to the students in individually package or served portions and prepared by a restaurant or food vendor that adheres to the CDC, state, and local guidelines regarding food safety and new policies regarding COVID-19.
- c. Light refreshments & snacks will also be provided during the day
- d. The students will be provided will plenty of water and Gatorade through the day.
- e. Students who own water camel packs are also permitted to use them while on the field if desired.

- f. As an annual mealtime tradition, we have MAIL TIME ENTERTAINMENT!
 - i. Parents, family, and friends are highly encouraged to either mail the school or drop off a card, letter, postcard, or a simple piece of fun mail for the kids during the week. Students must then provide mealtime entertainment such as telling a joke, showcasing a talent, performing a skit, etc in order to receive their mail!

9. <u>ATTIRE:</u>

- a. We recognize that the week of camp will be hot and so we encourage the students to wear comfortable and breathable clothing items.
- b. NOTE: school dress code still does apply during the week of camp. Please make sure that shorts and teeshirts are school appropriate in length and design.
- c. TANK TOPS with 3 fingers and athletic shorts that are "bend-over-able" please stick to the WAHS dress code.
- d. Stomach and midriff areas must be covered
- e. Sleeved shirts are recommended to keep the sun off the shoulders
- f. Compression shorts are encouraged to help prevent chaffing
- g. Anything not appropriate will result in parents being contacted and/or a band tee-shirt being provided
- h. It is recommended to bring 1 or 2 extra pairs of socks each day just in case of wet grass on the field
 - i. You may also want to bring plastic grocery bags to insulate socked feet inside of shoes for morning grass rehearsals
- i. Proper tennis shoe footwear is required for all rehearsals. No Sandals, slides, or Crocs!

10. MEDICAL INFORMATION:

- a. The band staff will provide a nurse and a first aid station.
- b. All medications will be checked in with the nurse on duty for the day and administered as needed by the nurse(s). Check-in will occur at the high school main entrance each day.
- c. All prescription medications will need to be accompanied with a parent signed medication authorization form detailed administration amounts, times, and restrictions.
- d. This form will be located is the band camp handbook packet.
- e. Each prescription needs to be in the original container
- f. Each needs to be placed in a zip lock bag with the medication form (located at the end of this message)
- g. Inhalers and Epipens MUST be carried by the student in the event of any immediate emergency, but we still need to have a form filled out.
- h. Students will need to provide the district and camp staff with the annual emergency medical forms, parent contact information, and proof of medical insurance in the event of an emergency.
- i. BRING AND APPLY SUNSCREEN!!!!

11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- a. All staff and students will be screened for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 prior to a rehearsal.
 - i. Screening includes a temperature check before they are permitted to enter the facility.
 - ii. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above or other signs of illness shall not be allowed to participate.
 - iii. Responses to screening questions for each person will be recorded and stored so that there is a record of everyone present in the event a student develops COVID-19 with appropriate attention being given to privacy and confidentiality.
 - iv. Any person with positive symptoms reported will not be allowed to take part in rehearsals and should contact his or her primary care provider or other appropriate health-care professional.
- b. Due to safety concerns, students will not be permitted to leave the Wilmington campus or its facilities during breaks, meals, or at any time until dismissed by the director or a staff member at the conclusion of the day's camp activities or for emergency reasons.
- c. For the safety of the students, all rehearsals will be "closed" in which unauthorized parents, spectators, and visitors will not be permitted to enter the facility, observe rehearsals, or interact with students, or parent volunteers.
- d. Any interference with the day-to-day activities, rehearsals, or activities without prior permission from the band staff to come onto campus will be dealt with by the band staff, school security, administration, and borough police as necessary. We have lots of work to do and the safety and security of our students, staff, and chaperones is our number one priority.

12. CURRENT MASK POLICY:

- a. In accordance with the lifting of the Pennsylvania mask mandate as of June 28, 2021, the district's policy is to allow parents, staff, chaperones, & students the ability to choose whether or not to wear a mask at this time (summer 2021).
- b. The CDC still recommends that adults and children who are NOT fully vaccinated (as defined as having two doses of the vaccine or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson) should still wear a mask when indoors or when in-close proximity to others for a sustained period of time.
- c. Adults and students who are fully vaccinated should also still consider wearing a mask if they live with someone at home who may still be unvaccinated or in an immunocompromised state.

- d. Students, parents, staff, and chaperones will be respectful to anyone who wishes to wear a mask at any time. Any disrespectful comments or actions which may intimidate others from doing what they feel is best for their health will be dealt with by the band staff and administration immediately and severely.
- e. We want all members of the band to feel safe and supported.
- f. Note: this policy is subject to change in accordance with current district, state, and local guidelines.

13. WEDNESDAY NIGHT ALUMNI NIGHT:

- a. Former students and alumni may visit Wednesday evening's practice as the band practices at the lower grass field between 7:00 9:00pm
- NOTE: This is not for parents since we have a planned parent preview show scheduled for Friday, July 30th and because we would like to keep our practice field area void of large crowds for safety and logistical reasons.
